Film composed of a 100-µm, calendered, monomeric PVC, which is coated with a pressuresensitive acrylic adhesive. For solvent, eco-solvent, latex and UV inkjet printing. Matt surface finish.

• Resistance to solvents: the adhesive is resistant to most chemicals (alcohol, diluted acids, oils).

#### **ADHESIVE:**

- Acrylic adhesive.
- Immediate and permanent adhesion.

#### **USER'S INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Touch-dry after less than 10 minutes depending on printer used.
- Do not leave the media on the printer while stopped.

Extended contact (over 6 hours) without use may cause the media to buckle while cooling.

- Recommended minimum application temperature: +10 °C (+50 °F).
- Operating temperature range (outdoors): -40 °C to +90 °C (-40 °F to +194 °F).
- Very good adhesion to glass, steel, aluminium, PVC, melamine, etc. <u>except grain substrates or</u> <u>substrates coated with acrylic paint.</u>
- In the case of an already painted substrate, self-adhesive media must only be applied to undamaged original paintwork. If the paintwork is not original and/or damaged, the application and the removal are at the judgement and risk of the installer.

## **OPERATING RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- For any lamination or other, optimal drying time for the inks is 24 hours minimum.
- The surface finish of your printings may be modified/improved/protected by laminating them with the appropriate laminate: V700 or V650. For UV printings, use the protective VCR650 laminate.

## **STORAGE:**

• Shelf life (before use):

The shelf life of this film is 1 year when stored upright in its original packaging in a dust-free environment at a temperature ranging from +15 °C to +25 °C (+59 °F to +77 °F) with relative humidity of 50 %.

#### **DURABILITY:** (Central European climate)

• Vertical outdoor exposure on flat surfaces: Unprinted: 4 years.
